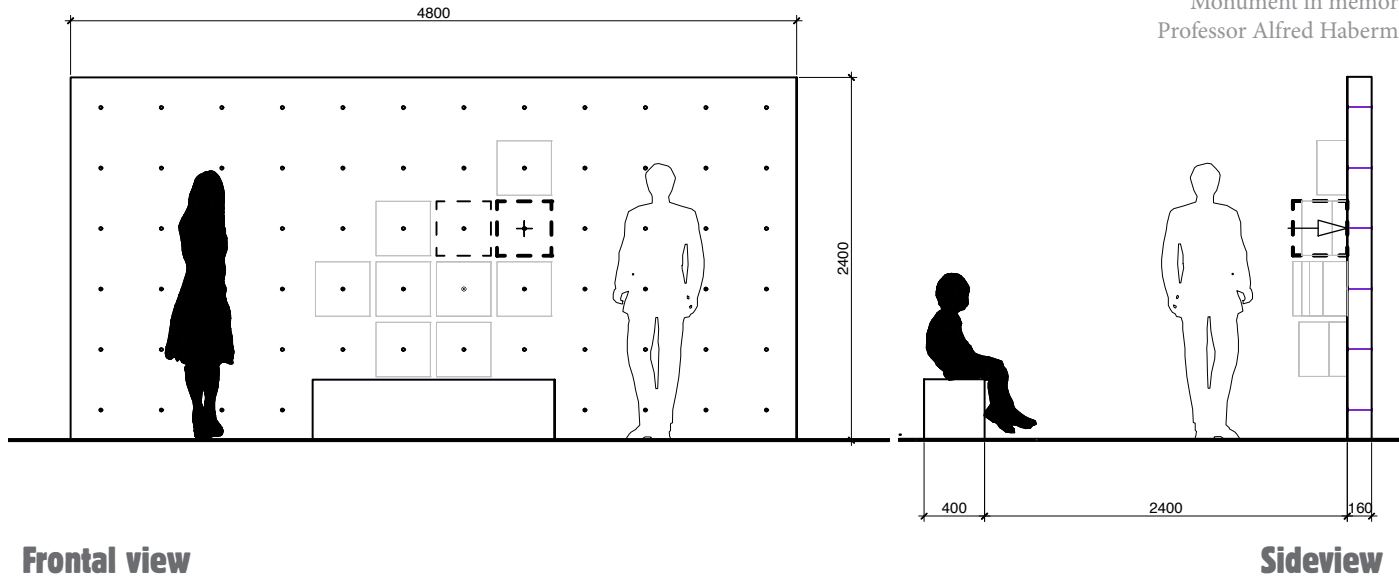

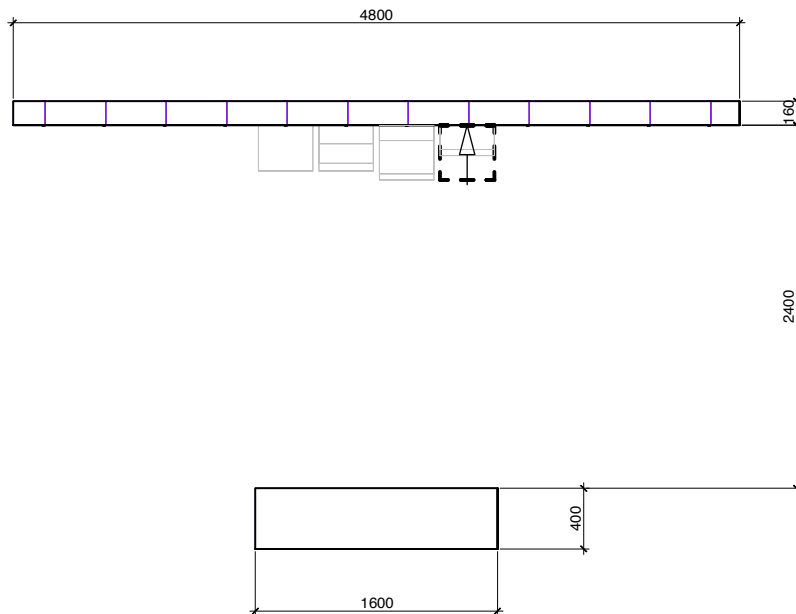
Individual contribution

Technical Details:

Basic material:

130 x 60 x 30mm industrial steel

Maximum size of final object:

350 x 350 x 350mm

We have cardboard boxes as transport help and to define this maximum size of object.

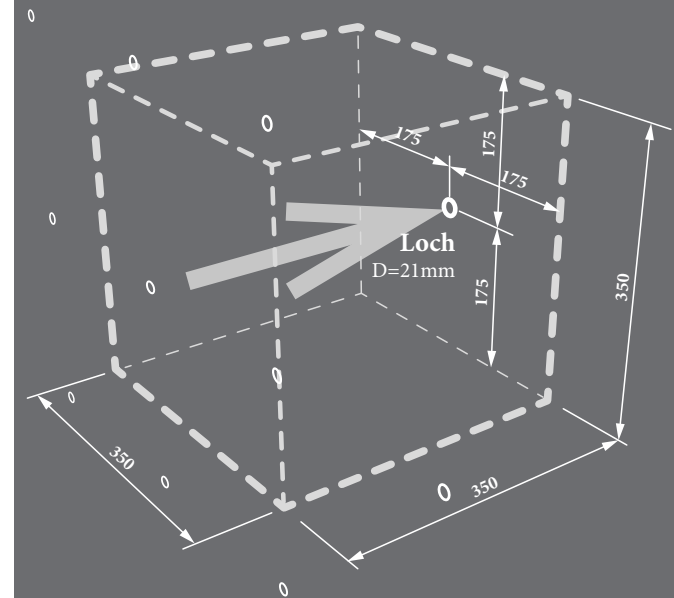
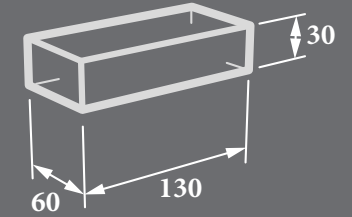
Fixing:

There is meant to be a hole of 21mm inner diameter for each individual object in the surface of the framing wall. The mode of fixing depends on every contributor him or herself.

Surface treatment of the finished element:

natural, brushed
(no oil, no wax)
